EIA's Renaissance Airport Hotel

One of Marriott's premiere boutique hotels, EIA's Renaissance Airport Hotel is the only Renaissance Hotel in the world attached to an airport.

The chic, urban Renaissance brand – Live Life to Discover – puts an emphasis on profiling local music and art and encourages travellers to take time to explore community attractions and events.

The hotel focuses on local flavour and is a perfect complement to our values as an airport.

The Renaissance hotel features functional public space for mingling, relaxing and gathering. The hotel has 213 rooms, including suites and a presidential suite. It also boasts a 5,600 square foot kitchen with banquet rooms with capacity for 450 people seated or 550 standing.

The hotel achieved new levels of comfort with modular solid wall construction that virtually eliminates noise transfer between suites, from the hallways and from the airfield. The windows feature triple-glazed, argon-filled bomb blast quality glass that will block any aircraft noise.

The Renaissance at EIA is the first hotel in Edmonton to comply with the stringent accessibility standards set out in the American Disabilities Act. As well, the hotel is the first in Edmonton to boast the prestigious Green Leaf status for energy conservation, resource conservation, environmental management and pollution prevention.

The hotel opened in May 2014 and quickly earned the top spot on TripAdvisor for Edmonton hotels.
